Height

In a cup, ice cube tray or container freeze any safe objects you have such as toy dinosaurs (or other small plastic toys). You job is to try and chip away at the ice to save your toys. Can you tell your adult what you want to use to help you chip away at the ice? What is happening to the ice when it is out of the freezer? Are there other ways that you could free the frozen toys?
