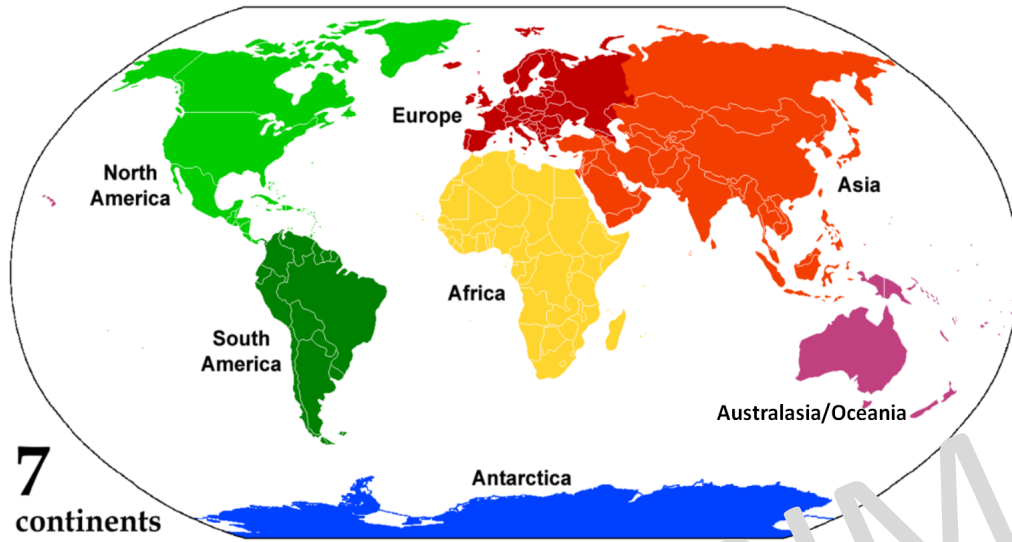




Where are the continents and oceans?

**Key Concepts**

Climate	The average measurements of temperature, wind, humidity, snow, and rain in a place over the course of years.
Settlement	Places where people live <b>or have moved to and remained.</b>
Trade	To take part in the exchange, purchase, or sale of goods
Weather	The state of the atmosphere at a particular place and time including the temperature, cloud cover, and moisture.

Continent	A very large area of land, one of the seven major areas of the Earth
Country	An area of land that is controlled by a single government
Direction	The general line that someone or something is moving or pointing in.
Ocean	A huge body of salt water
Population	All the people who live in a country or area.
Position	The place where a person or object is in relation to other things.
