- Dried rice or pasta
- Tinned vegetables (peas, carrots, sweetcorn, baked beans etc)
- Tinned soups
- Tinned fish
- Tinned fruit
- Breakfast cereals
- Biscuits
- UHT milk
- Shower gel for men or women
- Deodorants for men or women
- Toothpastes for adults or children
- Toothbrushes for adults or children
- Packets of toilet rolls

*Items we cannot make use of (because they cannot be stored):*

- Fresh fruit or vegetables
- Bread
- Dairy products (except UHT milk)
- Frozen or chilled goods
