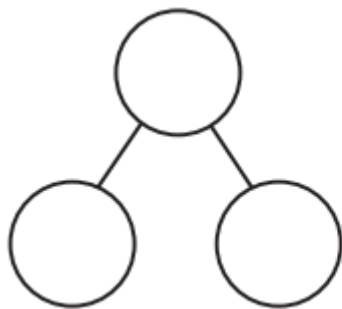

The rest of the animals are sheep.

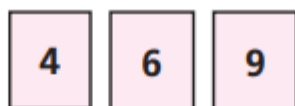
