Dear Parents / Carers,

I am now pleased to be able to give you the initial details of our educational visit to Hooke Court in February 2023. Previous year groups have had a wonderful time and gained from the experience. The theme of the trip is the Tudors and the children will be participating in dance, cooking, craft work and much more besides! I would strongly encourage your child to come and take part.

The total cost of the trip is approximately £163 which consists of **£146** Hooke Court fees and approximately **£17** coach transport. *(Unfortunately, I cannot give a definite price for the transport element yet as this cost will depend on the numbers attending and the number of coaches we need to hire however this is the maximum).* In order to confirm with Hooke Court, I need to know definite numbers of those wanting to attend the visit. If you would like your child to attend the visit, **please could pay your non-returnable £20 deposit on MCAS by Friday 30th September at the very latest.**

When you pay your deposit, you are giving your consent and commitment for your child to attend this residential visit. We are unable to change numbers once the deposit has been paid to Hooke Court as we will be charged for those places.

The key dates for payment are:

- **Friday 30th September - non-refundable deposit £20**
- **Final balances must be paid by Monday 9th January 2023**

A further payment plan to enable you to pay in instalments will follow in the next letter.

All payments must be made via the 'My Child at School' app/website only.

I will organise a meeting for parents soon where I can give you full details of the trip. However, please note, as for all residential visits, that you will be asked to complete a behaviour contract which states that, should your child's behaviour warrant it, you will need to collect them from Hooke Court without a refund.

In the meantime, if you have any questions, please do speak to your child's class teacher or ask to speak to me.
