
2.J Syllable Pyramids



Students read each syllable of a multi-syllable word in a pyramid. Then they reread the syllables and word until they can read the whole pyramid smoothly and fluently. If a child mispronounces a word, quickly and gently correct him or her and continue.

Materials Needed	Copy of a Syllable Pyramids page for each student (pp. 102–108)
Grades	3–8
Length of Activity	10–15 minutes
Location	school or home
Extension Ideas	 Challenge the student to read each word more than three times, or to try to beat his or her time the next day. Have the student orally create a sentence using each word.
