Dear Parents/Carers,

This term, our history unit has been 'World War Two'. In our learning, we have been considering the question: How was Great Britain affected by World War Two? We have looked at the lead up to the war, and then the subsequent major battles and events that Britain was involved in. This has included such events as rationing, evacuees, the Battle of Britain and the Blitz.

On **Wednesday 11th February**, we are going to dedicate a whole day to having a World War Two experience. Whilst we want to keep the day a surprise for the children, some of the planned activities include:

- Experiencing what it was like to be evacuated
- Anderson shelter visit
- Maths and English tasks – with 1940s style themed lessons
- Board games that would have been played in that era

As part of the experience, **we are asking the children to dress as a World War Two child evacuee**. We are not expecting any big expenditure in terms of clothing, and wearing the Talbot School uniform in a particular way will suffice. The children have worked extremely hard this term once again and we would like them to have a memorable day with their friends.
