authority	the right or power to give orders, make decisions, or control people
consequence	a result or effect
contribution	something that is contributed
democracy	a form of government in which power rests with the people, either directly or through elected representatives
democratic	relating to or demonstrating the belief that all people should be treated equally
excluded	to leave out; keep out
included	to put in a group or class
learning charter	agreed rules to follow at school
observer	someone who watches and listens at an event such as a meeting but does not participate in it
responsibilities	something for which a person is responsible; duty
rewards	something of value promised to someone for good works or deeds
rights	in keeping with the rules of justice, law, or society
role	a part played by a person or thing
school community	all individuals that are part of a school
valued	the worth, importance, or usefulness of something
voting	a formal expression of a choice in an election or group decision
